Terms of Reference

Officiating Working Group

Purpose of the group

- Promotes all umpiring courses through the county website and club contacts
- Raises the standard of umpiring by ensuring that sufficient and relevant courses are attended by all skill levels
- Liaises with the regional officiating lead to organise relevant umpiring courses in the county
- Books all venues for umpiring courses and liaise with the treasurer regarding invoices
- Develop and maintain a database of all qualified umpires and for umpire mentors
- Formulates an annual budget relating to the anticipated officiating activities for the ensuing year and submits to the CMB for its consideration
- Be represented at all CMB meetings
- Submits reports regarding officiating to the North Yorkshire County Management Board (NYCMB)
- Agrees with CMB its annual work plan
- Refer to the NYCMB for support and/or guidance regarding any matters which cause concern or which the Officiating Working Group is unable to resolve and/or deal with

Membership

The membership of the working group shall consist of the following:

- the lead of the working group, who is elected annually at the North Yorkshire Netball AGM
- additional volunteers who have the ability and desire to develop and enhance officiating within the county

Meetings

The group will hold one planning meeting annually and any subsequent meetings deemed necessary to enable the group to function and provide the desired levels of participation and competition. The group may form smaller working groups to enable more effective planning and organisation.

Brief notes of each meeting should be taken and circulated to the Chair of the CMB.
